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## 1 Introduction

This document describes the *nummat* option for the SVJOUR L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X 2<sub>ε</sub> document class. For details on manuscript handling and the review process we refer to the *Instructions for authors* in the printed journal. For style matters please consult previous issues of the journal.

## 2 Initializing the class

As explained in the main *Users guide* you can begin a document for *Numerische Mathematik* by including

```
\documentclass[nummat]{svjour}
```

as the first line in your text. All other options are also described in the main *Users guide*.

## 3 Extra commands

There is only one additional command:

```
\subclass{classification}
```

It is needed to specify the *Mathematics Subject Classification* at the end of the abstract. This command is similar to `\keywords` and should appear as the last command inside the *abstract* environment.
